



Porcelain Cleaning & Maintenance

Your Lucino porcelain benchtop is a durable, low-maintenance surface designed for everyday kitchen use. Following these simple care recommendations will help maintain its finish and appearance for years to come.

Cleaning & Maintenance Instructions

Everyday Cleaning

Clean the benchtop regularly with warm soapy water, and a soft microfibre cloth or non-abrasive sponge. Rinse with clean water and wipe dry to minimise streaking and residue.

Wipe up spills promptly, particularly coffee, tea, wine, oils and strongly coloured foods. For stubborn marks, use a non-abrasive cleaner suitable for porcelain surfaces and follow the cleaner manufacturer's instructions.

Protecting Your Benchtop

Although porcelain is highly resistant to heat, staining and scratching, reasonable care should always be taken.

Heat & Impact

The surface is extremely hard; however, like other premium porcelain and stone surfaces, edges and corners can chip if subjected to a heavy or sharp impact. Particular care should be taken around sinks, cooktops and exposed edges.

Important Warranty Care

Proper care protects your warranty. Keep your documents and follow care instructions for a lasting Lucino benchtop.

Damage resulting from misuse, excessive impact, standing or sitting on the benchtop, excessive loading, inappropriate cleaning products, or alterations carried out after installation may not be considered a product or installation defect.

Keep your original purchase and installation documentation and follow any specific care or warranty instructions supplied by your benchtop fabricator, kitchen supplier or Lucino product supplier.

With normal household care, your Lucino porcelain benchtop will provide a durable, hygienic and attractive kitchen surface for many years.
